

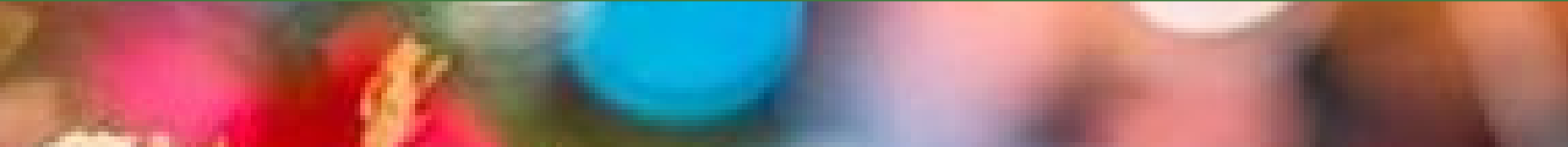

New Fitness Court Opens at Blair Park

Community members were excited to try out the newest addition to Blair Park, an innovative seven station outdoor Fitness Court to encourage wellness, at a ribbon cutting held on Wednesday, November 9. Students from Cal State San Bernardino's Kinesiology Department were just as excited to demonstrate the equipment.

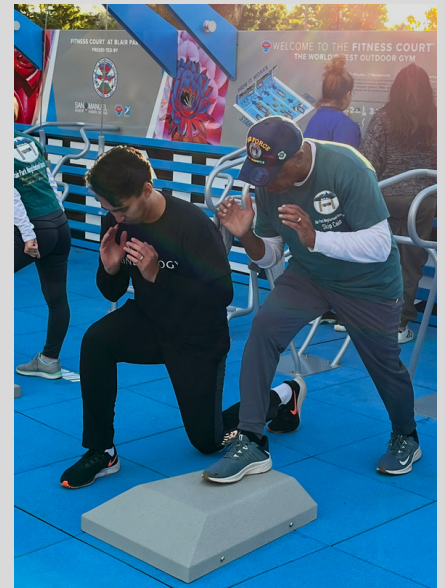
The Mayor and City Council members, City commissioners, the Blair Park Neighborhood Association, and representatives of Assemblymember James Ramos and San Manuel joined community members at the ceremony.

The Fitness Court at allows users to leverage their own body weight to get a complete workout using a station-to station format. Adaptable for people at all fitness levels, the National Fitness Campaign (NFC) developed the concept to inspire municipalities to transform public spaces into community fitness hubs.

San Bernardino was selected to receive a \$30,000 grant from NFC to help support the construction of the court, along with additional funding from the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians and the California Parks and Recreation Society.

One feature of the Blair Park Fitness Court that impressed the attendees was the locally inspired mural and artwork representing San Bernardino's history and culture by local artist Darren Villegas. Villegas was selected earlier this year by the City Arts and Historical

Preservation Commission as part of a competition to select a local artist for the Fitness Court.

Animal Services Offering Free Microchipping of Pets for Local Residents

In an effort to ensure lost pets are reunited with their owners during the holidays, the City of San Bernardino Animal Services Department will be offering residents of San Bernardino and Loma Linda the chance to microchip their pets for free through December 31. Grant funding from the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians and the California Animal Welfare Funders Collaborative is making this opportunity possible.

Microchipping is available Tuesday through Saturday between 10AM and 4PM at the Shelter, located at 333 Chandler Place in San Bernardino. No appointment is necessary. The microchipping and registration into the pet ID database only takes a few minutes.

"Microchipping is far and away the best way to quickly get lost or stolen pets back to their families," said San Bernardino Animal Services Director Kris Watson. "Thanks to scanning, our Animal Control officers are often able to immediately return lost pets to their homes without ever bringing the animals into the Shelter."

A study by Ohio State University found that microchipped cats were 20 times more likely to be reunited with their families than non-microchipped cats and microchipped dogs were reunited at a rate 2.5 times more often than dogs that weren't microchipped.

Pet microchips are implantable computer chips that encode a unique identification number to help reunite owners with their lost pet. They are no bigger than a grain of rice and they are placed under a pet's skin. The procedure is quick and painless for the animal. Unlike collars and ID tags, they can never break or fall-off. When the chip is scanned, the pet's encoded chip identification is recognized by the scanner. With the chip identification number in hand, reuniting a pet with their family is only a phone call away.



FREE Pet Microchips!

From now through December 31st, residents from the cities of San Bernardino and Loma Linda can have their dog or cat microchipped for free!

Street Improvements Continue in SB

Breeze Airways Expands its Service to SBD

Barely three months since becoming the first commercial airline to fly out of San Bernardino International Airport, Breeze Airways announced the addition of service to Las Vegas, Nevada and Hartford, Connecticut from San Bernardino starting in February.



With airfare to Las Vegas starting at less than \$30, airport officials are hoping that

Breeze and other airlines will become a preferred option for local travelers. In July, Breeze launched local service to San Francisco and Provo.

Street Improvements Continue on Sierra Way

Work continues on improvements to a 27-block stretch of Sierra Way between 3rd Street and 30th Street. Encompassing two-and one-half miles of roadway and three Council Wards (1, 2 and 7), the \$2 million project includes pavement replacement and rehabilitation, the installation of ADA accessible ramps, and construction of new sidewalks to connect existing gaps.

According to Alex Qishta, Deputy Director of Public Works/City Engineer, work is also planned for an additional segment of Sierra Way, between 30th and 40th Streets. However, that additional segment, which will also include storm drain work, will not occur until after the completion of this project.



The current project is expected to be completed in March 2023.

New Museum Exhibit to Recognize SBPD's First Female African American Police Officer

On Tuesday, November 22 at 6PM, the San Bernardino Police Historical Society will be unveiling its newest addition to the Police Department Museum with an exhibit recognizing retired police officer Sherri Adams, San Bernardino's first African American female police officer. The community is encouraged to attend.

The museum is located inside the City's main police station at 710 N. D Street. The museum is free and open to the public.

Adams joined the San Bernardino Police Department in 1985 and was the agency's first female African American officer. Due to her youthful appearance, immediately after graduation from the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Academy, she was placed into SB City schools as an undercover officer working narcotics cases. During her six months in this assignment, her work lead to many arrests.



Officer Adams worked assignments in patrol, narcotics, bicycle mounted enforcement team (BMET), and was a part of the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) team. She also worked as a background investigator in our Personnel and Training Unit.

During her career with the San Bernardino Police Department Officer Adams received numerous awards and commendations including Narcotics Unit Citation, Chief's Commendation for her participation on the Honor Guard detail, and DARE Unit Citation. Officer Adams was nominated for



the Woman of Achievement award twice and was also nominated for Officer of the Year in 1995. Officer Adams retired from the San Bernardino Police Department in February 2001.

Officer Adams, we thank you for your service to the residents of San Bernardino and to the San Bernardino Police Department. You have been an inspiration for those who have followed after you!

Police Educate Students About the Dangers of Drugs and Alcohol During Red Ribbon Week

On October 24, San Bernardino Police Officers visited a student assembly at Bing Wong Elementary School to talk about the dangers of drugs and alcohol during the Red Ribbon Week.

Red Ribbon Week is an alcohol, tobacco, and other drug and violence prevention awareness campaign observed annually in October. It began as a tribute to fallen DEA special agent Enrique Camerena in 1985. It is the nation's largest and longest running drug awareness and prevention program.

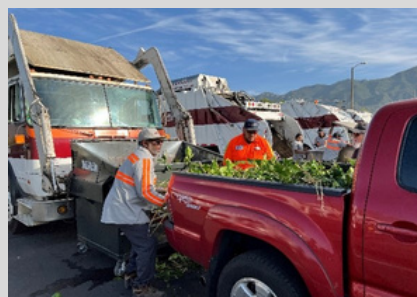


Next Community Dump Day is Set for November 19 at Perris Hill Park

The final free monthly Community Dump Day of the year will take place on Saturday, November 19 from 8AM to 11AM at Perris Hill Park, located at 1135 E. Highland Avenue.

San Bernardino residents can discard bulky items (appliances, mattresses, furniture), tires, tree limbs, e-waste and metal. Construction and Hazardous materials will not be accepted. Proof of residency with either ID or a utility bill must be shown.

Community dump days occur the last Saturday of every month at a selected location. Due to the Thanksgiving Holiday weekend, the November event will take place one week early. For more information, call (909) 384-7272.



Important Dump Site Information

City of San Bernardino residents may drop off unwanted items such as appliances, mattresses, tires, furniture, tree limbs and electronic waste.

- This is for household refuse only.
- Be prepared to show proof of residency with a driver's license or gas/electric/water bill.
- **NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS** - This includes paints, oil, batteries and household or industrial chemicals, etc.
- **NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS** - This includes concrete, brick, drywall and roofing material.
- **NO COMMERCIAL VEHICLES** - Includes enclosed U-Haul/rental moving trucks or Business Vehicles

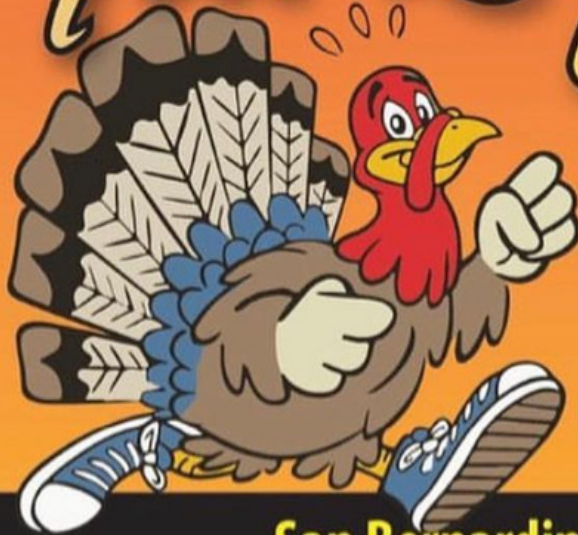



Taking Care of Your Pets

Pet Safety Tips for the Holidays



Pets and Guests

- Some pets may be overwhelmed by visitors. Set up a safe space for them before your guests arrive - this could be a crate or a quiet room.
- Let your guests know about your pet(s) before they arrive.
- Make sure your pets are secured while visitors enter and exit your home so they can't escape through an open door.

Pets and Table Food

- Some human foods can be harmful or even fatal to your pet - make sure your family members and visitors don't share their plates with your pets.
- Always make sure trash, especially anything with food, is secure so that your pet can't get to it.
- Below is a short list of foods that are harmful to pets:
 - Bones - These can splinter after the pet eats them, causing injuries to your pet's digestive tract, leading to severe complications or death.
 - Candy, including chocolate or anything with the sweetener Xylitol - these ingredients are toxic to dogs, cats and other small pets.
 - Coffee
 - Grapes and raisins
 - Onions
 - Garlic
 - Citrus food and pits from cherries, apples, peaches, etc
 - Nuts
 - Leaves and stems from vegetables
 - If you aren't sure, don't share! Food and treats made specifically for pets are always safest!



Pets and Holiday Decorations

- Keep your pet from chewing on tree limbs or greenery.
- Cats and some dogs may try to climb the tree, knocking it over.
- If you use tinsel, put it on the top of the tree where your pet can't reach. This decoration can cause injuries and or/blockage in your pet's digestive tract if they eat it.
- Water in the base of your Christmas tree may contain chemicals that are harmful - don't let your pet drink it.
- Ivy, Holly, Mistletoe, Poinsettias and some Lilies are poisonous to pets.

In Case of Emergency

- Make sure your pet is microchipped or has a collar with an ID tag and your phone number.
- Know where your closest 24/7 emergency vet is located.
- Contact the ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center at (888) 426-4435 (fees may apply).



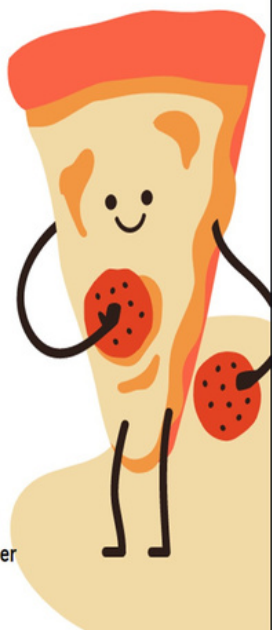
