

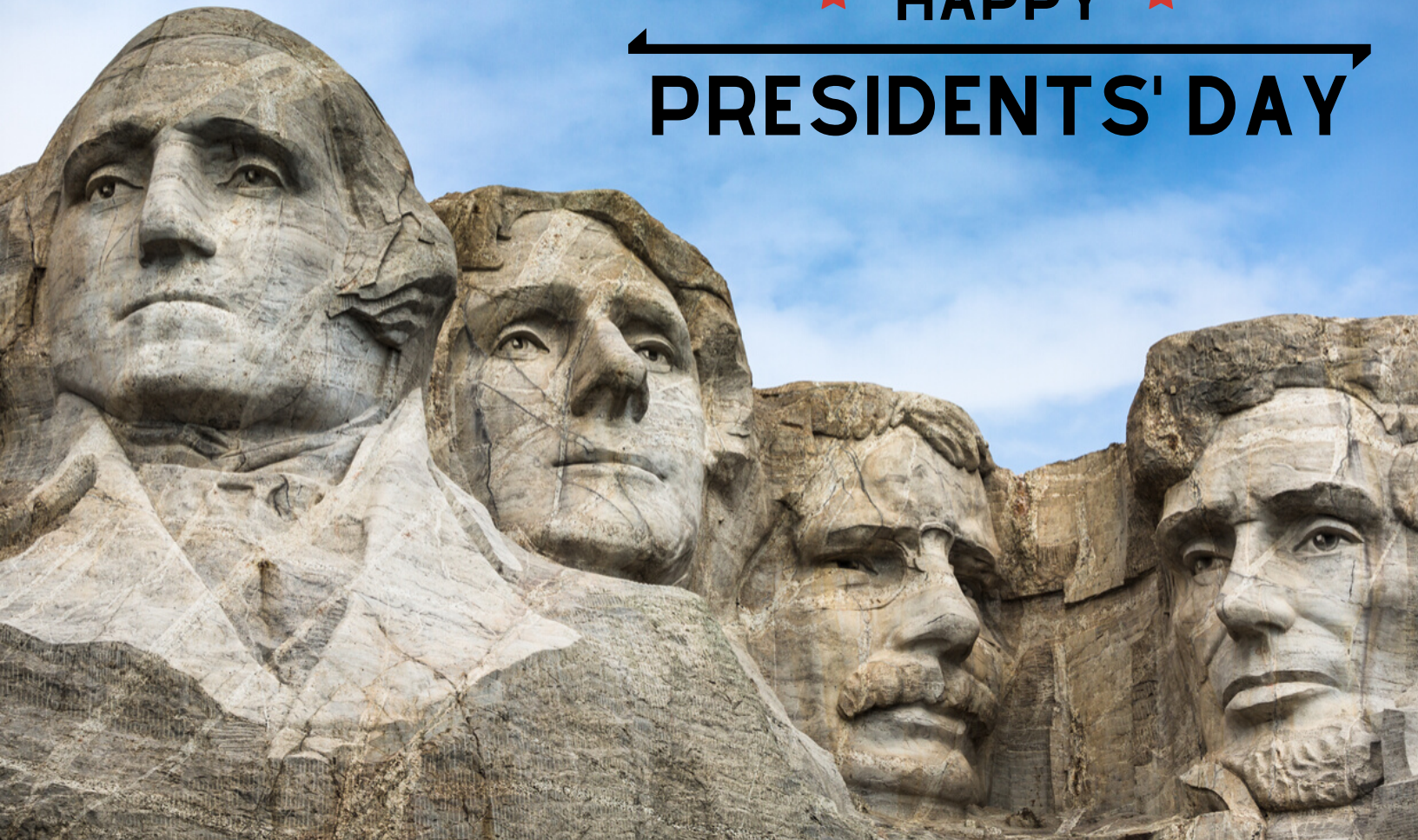

Be Counted, San Bernardino!

Take action this spring to be counted in the 2020 Census! In partnership with the State of California, U.S. Census Bureau and San Bernardino residents like you, we will make every effort to count all residents in the City of San Bernardino. Results are used to determine how federal funds are distributed to states and local governments for vital community services, including, housing and community development, health and human services, transportation, workforce development, environmental protection and public safety. The Census data are also used for apportionment of Congressional seats and redistricting at all levels of government. The State of California receives approximately \$77 billion in federal funding.



What is the Census?

The Census counts the population in all 50 states and other territories to create a snapshot of our nation. This once-a-decade census is so important because the data helps businesses, researchers and communities make decisions.



When is it coming?

In March 2020, The U.S. Census Bureau will mail every household information and how to access the form.

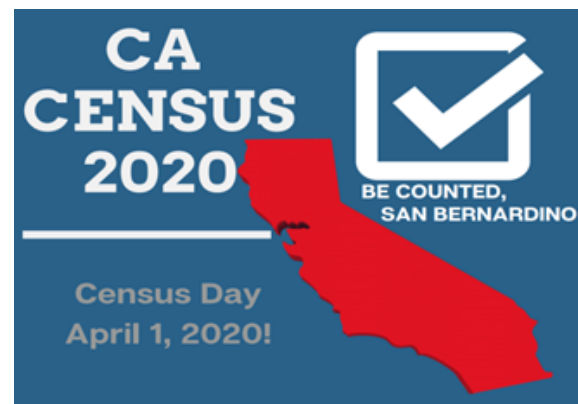
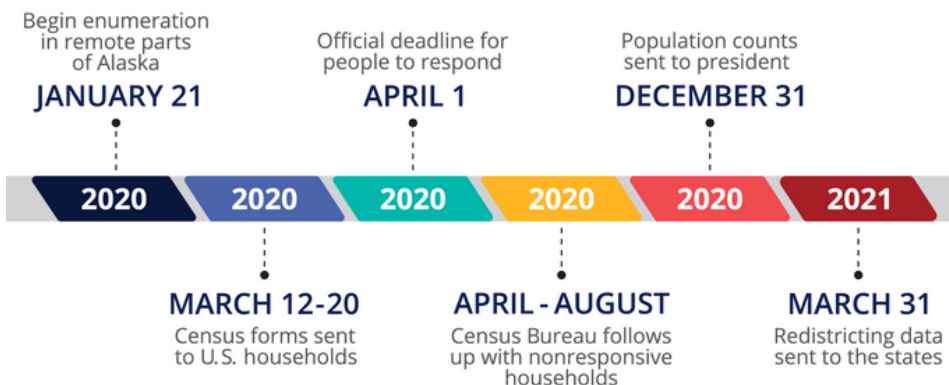


How can I fill it out?

Norton Science & Language Academy Gets a New Location!

The Norton Science and Language Academy currently located at 505 E. Central Avenue, will be relocating to their recently approved 16-acre campus on the northwest corner of S. Waterman Avenue and E. Valley Street. Construction is scheduled to start this Spring in order to commence classes for the 2021 school year. The state-of-the-art campus, for students K-12, features eight (8) buildings clustered around three (3) separate quads for classrooms, an indoor gymnasium, administrative facilities, along outdoor basketball courts, playgrounds and an athletic field. At full capacity, the Norton Science and Language Academy will employ approximately 130 staff members, that will provide services to a maximum of 1,450 students.



San Bernardino Welcomes Eastgate Air Cargo Facility

The San Bernardino International Airport has approved Hillwood's \$200-million redevelopment of existing infrastructure as an air cargo distribution center. The expansion is anticipated to generate 3,800 new jobs and an additional \$5 million in annual revenue for the publicly-owned airport. Hillwood is planning a 658,500 sf building for sorting air cargo; two 25,000 sf ground support buildings; approximately 41 acres of structural apron; and taxi lanes for aircraft parking and positioning. The project is visible from 3rd Street just past Del Rosa Drive. Grading and Construction have already begun, and completion is set to come at year's end.

Hudson Park gets a FUN upgrade!

KaBOOM!, the Los Angeles Kings, Los Angeles Galaxy, and San Manuel Casino have sponsored the build of an accessible playground at Hudson Park. The new playground will be an inclusive structure that will allow children of all abilities to engage in play. The new design will enable individuals with developmental disabilities to access the play equipment and engage in inclusive play with their peers.

The Parks, Recreation and Community Services and Public Works Departments, along with sponsors, local neighborhood associations, City of San Bernardino Center for Individual Development (CID) Sunshine Club, and community members held a Design Day on January 23rd at Kendall (Carmack) Elementary School. The day included an interactive Kids Session to design the "ideal playground" and an Adult Session to discuss the logistics of the new play structure and activities leading up to the actual Build Day which is scheduled for Friday, April 10, 2020.

Building Bridges and Breaking Barriers



What is the CID? In 1975 Margaret Relph, founder of the Merri-Mixer Program, began to lobby the City of San Bernardino for a recreation center for people with developmental disabilities. On October 24, 1980, the Center for Individuals with Disabilities center opened. The center is located at 8088 Palm Lane, and is now managed and operated by the City of San Bernardino Parks, Recreation & Community Services Department under the supervision of Christopher McClain, Acting Community Center Services Supervisor.

The CID facility offers Merri-Mixers Program (ages 23 and up); Water Babies (June-July); Adult Water exercise, Teen/Sunshine Club After School Program (3 years and up) and an Aerobics class. The facility has an indoor 92-degree swimming and therapy pool for registered participants use and a community garden. The main goal of the CID is to increase the quality of life through recreation by working with individuals on life skills to make them more productive in their daily lives. Some lessons include: person to person introductions, mannerism and discussing likes and dislikes.

These topics help to encourage and motivate individuals with developmental disabilities on their path to individuality and set the ground work for positive and healthy relationships with their peers. It is important to the CID that the participants recognize that their disability is not a disabling affect but that they have abilities and can make an impact in their lives, families, and communities.

The Center would not be open today without the support of the Friends of CID, a nonprofit organization dedicated to fundraising efforts through events which allow programming and extra-curricular activities for participants. The Friends of CID have allowed participants to enjoy annual trips to Disneyland and the Aquarium of the Pacific, a CID Prom, CID Awards Night, Family Day and Center Aquatics Programs just to name a few. The next event is a Murder Mystery Dinner Fundraiser on Thursday, February 27th from 6:00pm to 9:00pm at the Elks Lodge located at 2055 Elks Dr, San Bernardino. The cost for attendance is \$45 per person or \$80 per couple. The proceeds will go to the Friends of CID to continue to support the program.
