Waterman/Baseline Investment

The City is excited to announce that National CORE was awarded the Chase PRO Neighborhood Investment for the Waterman/Baseline area of our city. This investment will focus on creating what is called a "Complete Community;" which includes housing, a K-12 school, parks and recreation network, community shopping, quality jobs, public facilities and supporting infrastructure. All of these elements combine to improve education, recreation and sustainable living in the area and are developed through input from the community. Mt. Vernon Viaduct Project

The Mt. Vernon Viaduct project is moving right along! This project will replace the existing bridge with a new wider, longer bridge that will provide better connectivity to the area. The bridge will be built to current standards that will allow emergency vehicle and bus services to be restored across the bridge. This will help to reduce emergency response times and shorten commute time for those who rely on the bus system. Additionally, the construction will provide new safety features such as bike lanes, wider sidewalks and a new center median separating northbound and southbound lanes. As construction begins early next year, the existing bridge will be closed to traffic and detours and accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists will be implemented.
