# **Ground Breaking!**

Crestview Terrace is the newest and third phase of the larger Arrowhead Grove Neighborhood Revitalization and continues to transform a 1940's public housing site into a high-quality modern community.





Crestview Terrace will provide 184 apartment homes for individuals and families with incomes beginning at 30% of the area median income. Crestview Terrace will be the first phase to offer market-rate units for the local workforce. This project continues National CORE's commitment to sustainable development and will utilize renewable energy source to offset one-third of the total site energy, creating a carbon-neutral neighborhood. The groundbreaking will take place January 16th, at 10am.



If you have been wondering what has been going on with the demolition at the auto center, we're excited to announce that Toyota of San Bernardino will be starting constructing on a new, 80,000 square foot state of the art facility within the Auto Center. Previously home to Scion of San Bernardino, the new facility will be located at 650 W. Auto Center Drive, fronting the 215 freeway.

Currently, all existing buildings on the property have been demolished and site preparation is underway.

When complete, the new facility will consist of a new 26,000 square foot showroom building and 55,000 square foot service building. Construction is anticipated to begin soon, with a planned opening in early 2021.

## City Buildings get much needed upgrades!



The Public Works Department recently completed roof replacements at three City facilities including the Rudy C. Hernandez Community Center located at 222 N Lugo Ave, the 5th Street Senior Center located at 600 W 5th Street, and the Delmann Heights Community Center located at 2969 N Flores. The Animal Shelter will also be getting a much needed new roof this spring. Roof leaks could damage the

buildings' interior contents and lead to structural deterioration. The new roofing materials are warrantied for 30 years, helping to eliminate further structural deterioration and enabling the City to continue to provide community services in these facilities for years to come.









