## Rendezvous Back to Route 66

Thanks to the San Bernardino Area Chamber of Commerce, the city-sponsored Rendezvous Back to Route 66 event was held on October 6th in Downtown San Bernardino! This event brought 1,000 classic cars and even more spectators that lined the streets of downtown. The first Rendezvous took place in 1990 at Glen Helen Regional Park in Devore with 300 vehicles and about 4,000 spectators who enjoyed a cruise down "E" Street & a concert. The Rendezvous moved to the heart of downtown San Bernardino in 1992. That year, more than 700 vehicles filled the streets in celebration of the 66th anniversary of Route 66 "The Mother Road." This year the family-friendly event featured live music, vendors, a beer garden and Kid's Zone.



## Broadmoor Boulevard

The City of San Bernardino's Public Works Department has been working diligently to identify locations throughout the city that are in need of water efficient landscaping and aesthetic improvements. The Water Department, Valley District, and East Valley Water District agreed to each contribute \$500,000, for a total of \$1,500,000 for the installation of water efficient landscape improvements in various areas of the City.

Broadmoor Boulevard, between 30th Street and Parkdale Drive, was identified through this plan. The purpose of the project was to enhance the aesthetics of the immediate neighborhood community and the driving experience of the motorists. The project included drought tolerant plants in combination with hardscaping and a drip-irrigation system that reduces water consumption and future maintenance costs of the area.

Additionally, 32 existing decorative concrete street light poles have been upgraded from a high-voltage lighting system to a new 120/240V LED system creating a much more effective and energy efficient lighting system.





## Arrowhead Grove Phase II

The City is excited to announce the Arrowhead Grove project is now in the second phase! This project is comprised of the ongoing redevelopment of Waterman Gardens, a 252-unit public housing project that was built in the 1940s as housing for workers in the WW II defense industries. At build-out, it is anticipated that the redevelopment of Waterman Gardens will result in 411 residential units, commercial space and a community center. The Arrowhead Grove community also includes an on-site Headstart facility for preschool age children. In November 2016, Valencia Vista opened with 76 affordable units and in 2017 Olive Meadow debuted with 62 affordable housing units.



## SBPD Participates in the Pink Patch Project & No Shave November

The San Bernardino Police Department has joined the Pink Patch Project initiative for the 4th consecutive year. Officers can opt to swap out their traditional SBPD patch for a pink patch during the month of October. This initiative helps to raise awareness around breast cancer and other illnesses by opening up conversations about the pink patch during interactions between officers and the community. In addition to the pink patches, officers also have the option to participate in "No Shave November" in partnership with Loma Linda University Cancer Center. During "No Shave November", participants sacrificed shaving and grooming in order to raise awareness about cancer prevention, diagnosis and treatment. Commemorative coins, pink patches, and t-shirts are all sold with proceeds benefiting the Loma Linda University Cancer Center.
